ARE MFC FEES VALUE FOR MONEY?

Where does my money go?

These are common questions and ones that are important for our members to understand. Registration fees paid by players are made up of the following but not limited to:

- Football Federation Australia (FFA) fees (per player)
- Football Queensland fees (per player)
- Football Gold Coast fees (per player)
- Insurance (per player)
- Referee fees
- Field maintenance / marking
- TSC lease costs of training & playing fields
- Coaching fees (SIBA Soccer U6-U11)
- Utilities
- Training equipment
- Field electricity, leases & water
- Playing kit
- Staff costs (Admin, Cleaner, Canteen Management) – continued lack of volunteers (1 new committee member in past 3 seasons)

Are MFC fees value for money?

We strongly believe so! Not only does MFC football provide valuable social and physical development MFC also provides a friendly team environment and a strong sense of community. We have also presented an analysis of costs per MFC contact session based on the following assumptions.

Based on an approximate 20 week season (excluding junior carnivals) this translates to 2 training sessions (in most age groups) and 1 game per week. Several sessions are also run (and paid for by MFC) by the highly qualified SIBA Soccer coaches in the u6-u11 age groups.

In most age groups there are therefore up to 3 contact sessions per week of approximately 1 hour each. This can be translated as follows as a \$ cost per MFC contact session as follows:

It is fair to say when this is compared with other sports and activities available to the kids of our area that MFC provides a very competitive offer and value for money. Not to mention a sporting hobby that can open up so many other opportunities in later life.

Why is my fee different to other age groups?

MiniRoos football is non-competitive therefore there is less administration meaning less Federation fees charged by the FFA, FQ and FGC. Older age groups also more often play and train under lights compared with MiniRoos football. Junior competitive teams also train twice a week, requiring larger field spaces, therefore incurring higher facility and overhead costs over the course of the season. There are also higher referees fees for the older age groups.
